### Camp Magruder:



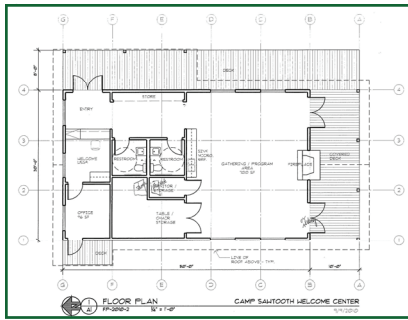
Before and after photos of the “Huffman House”— what a difference! \$50,000 will complete this project, giving us a two bedroom retreat house for family or small group use.
